

Wüsthof factory is Environmentally friendly.

- The water used for cooling in the knife grinding process is cleaned and processed then, goes back into circulation. Therefore, the water consumption in our Solingen, Germany factories is reduced by 95%.
- The grinding mud that is created from numerous stages in the production of each knife is systematically collected, stored briefly, then recycled.
- The air at our grinding machines is pulled away and cleaned through filter fabrics to prevent small steel particles from human respiration and from being released into the environment.
- All steel waste originating from production is saved and shipped to German steel manufacturers for recycling.
- The world-wide headquarters in Germany is also intentional with waste in our offices. Plastics, glass, printer cartridges, batteries and a variety of paper products are sorted and organized for recycling by all Wüsthof employees.
- Cutlery forging units are sitting on enormous cushioned bases to prevent shock waves from transferring from the factory and into the environment. Noise pollution has been eliminated from surrounding neighborhoods in Solingen.
